Sean Segal, Class of 2017



Sean Segal, LCHS class of 2017, is an accomplished musician and vocalist. He just graduated from the University of Michigan in 2021 with a BMA in Multidisciplinary Studies. His BMA is a music degree that allowed him to study both jazz and music tech. He was then accepted into USC's Screen Scoring Masters Program and is currently continuing his music studies working towards his masters degree. Graduates of this program have gone on to write the original scores for *Frozen*, *The Mandalorian*, *Black Panther*, *A Quiet Place* and *Wandavision*... to name a few.

At LCHS, Sean spent six years in the choir program which “absolutely shaped my middle school and high school experience.” As a 7th and 8th grader, he sang with the 7/8 Mixed Choir as well as the Men's Ensemble. He joined the Concert Choir as a Freshman and enjoyed a “seriously fun tour to Seattle.” From his Sophomore year onward, he was in Chamber singers which was one of the most memorable periods of his life. Segal fondly recalls the annual Chamber Singer choir retreats to Hartland where “for a weekend we were surrounded by nature and an incredibly serene sense of silence that allowed us to develop a deep connection with all around us.”

In addition to his time in the choir program, he also performed in several LCHS musical theatre productions during high school. Sean played the Baker in their 2015 production of *Into The Woods* and Captain Von Trapp in the 2016 production of *The Sound of Music*.

Mr. Segal credits choir director Dr. Jeff Brookey for creating an environment that allowed students to learn and grow as people and as musicians stating “on top of being a masterful musician, Dr. Brookey is an incredible mentor. His incredible vulnerability and kindness helps create an atmosphere that fosters the personal and musical growth of his students.”
